- Provide guidance and support to coaches to ensure they deliver high-quality coaching sessions that focus on developing skills, game understanding, physical abilities and psycho-social well-being.
- Collaborate with the club's leadership team to determine team, coaching, and player assignments and roster management for age groups and individual teams
- Oversee team placement in leagues, divisions, and tournament participation
- Work with the club's leadership team to provide tryout organization and oversight
- Coordinate player placement with coaches through tryouts as well as in-season opportunities for players to gain additional playing time and development
- Ensure playing time philosophy of teams supports the club's vision as outlined and supports age specific curriculum goals for player development
- Together with club leadership, organize and present the Club's strategy, goals, and status to parents in each age group at least once a season
- Work with the club's leadership team to identify and recruit talented coaches to the club
- Attend training sessions, games, and tournaments to monitor coaching performance and provide feedback and support to our coaches and to ensure they are meeting the required club standards per the club's guidelines.
- Develop and oversee a strong, consistent, and transparent communication program between coaches and players/families
